

FAQ

Q. What are your rates?

A. *This wedding season for 2017 I have a running special called the Wedding Services Package for the bride and up to 4 attendants! Extra attendants requiring makeup may get services for \$40 per person. Details for what this package includes may be reviewed on the **Services** page of my website. If you feel you are not eligible for this package, please send an email inquiry for a quote.*

Q. Do you do hair?

A. *Bringing out your unique beauty using the most innovative, skin loving products out there is my passion! This means I spend 110% of my time doing research, taking classes and workshops, keeping up with all of the latest trends and techniques to bring to you the very best that bridal beauty has to offer! That leaves me zero time for hair. I do, however, consistently work with amazing, talented hair stylists so feel free to inquire for a referral!*

Q. How long does the makeup last?

A. *My makeup applications last all day and all night until you take it off! You will need to touch up your lip color so choosing a lip color you love to tuck into your clutch would be a great idea! My wedding packages come with a complimentary touch up kit for all your touch up needs plus (if you don't have your own lip color) swatches of enough lip product for 3 applications and disposable doe's foot applicators.*

Q. How many people can you apply make up on?

A. *I can apply makeup on anywhere between 8-10 people depending on the intricacy of the look. Any more than that may require the use of an assistant.*

Q. How long does it take to apply makeup?

A. *Due to the luxury skin prep included in my Wedding Service Package, I give ample time for up to 1 hour and 20 minutes for my brides. Makeup for attendants I allot 45 minutes in my scheduling but typically run about 30 minutes per attendant.*

Q. What products do you use? Do you sell makeup?

A. I use a variety of high end and luxury products. My skin care, prep and foundations are all skincare based makeup that is both non comedogenic, and hypoallergenic. For a more detailed look at what I use, please click [HERE](#)

Q. Do you only do make up on San Juan Island or do you travel to other islands and the mainland?

A. I travel everywhere and anywhere my work takes me whether it's local or far away! So far my work has taken me all over the Pacific Northwest including Oregon, as well as California and as far as New York City!

Q. How far are you willing to travel?

A. The world is our oyster! I will travel all over the United States, Canada and most countries!

Q. What travel fees apply?

A. Travel fees may include airfare, hotel lodging, parking fees, transportation and incidentals. For weddings in WA State, ferry fees may apply.

Q. What are your location fees?

A. This wedding season, I have created a 2017 special wedding package that is not only cost effective for every budget but allows me to waive the location fee all together. Please refer to my [Services](#) page for details!

Q. Is the bride responsible for paying for her bridesmaids/ attendants makeup?

A. Absolutely not! That is up to the discretion of the bride. Most bridesmaids and other wedding attendants nowadays are used to paying for their own makeup services. I do however, typically require payment to come from one source and typically by the person who signs the service agreement.

Q. Is a consult/makeup preview required? When should I book a preview?

A. A consult/makeup preview --- also known as a trial --- is not required, but extremely recommended so we don't have to waste your precious 'getting ready' time trying to figure out the exact look you're going for. A trial ensures the longevity and perfection for how your makeup wears throughout the day and night!

I recommend your trial the day before your wedding-- especially if you are having a rehearsal-- that way you can test how it wears and lasts through the night as well as get

feedback from your loved ones! (You can choose a different lip color to alter the look so it's not exactly the same as your bridal look, up to you!)

Q. When should I book my wedding day services?

A. *I would love for you to book your services as soon as you know your date! The San Juan Islands are one of the most popular, sought after locations for destination weddings --- which means vendors and beauty service providers get booked **fast!** It's wise to reserve your date as soon as possible.*

Q. Do you come to me on my wedding day?

A. *Yes! It is my pleasure to come to you on your wedding day so you may get ready surrounded in comfort by all your friends and loved ones!*

Q. How do I book you?

A. *Instructions are detailed on the **Services** page of my website. The Communication typically begins by filling out a form from my website requesting a date or two you have in mind to check for availability and we go from there. Your date is then reserved as 'pending'. Once I receive your signed Service Agreement and deposit, I remove the 'pending' status and secure your date!*

Q. How do I get a Service Agreement?

A. *To download a Service Agreement, you would go to the **Service** page of my website, scroll ALL the way down to the end of the page until you see all of my social media icons. Below those icons you will find the link to download a Service Agreement*

Q. How much is the deposit?

A. *The deposit varies as it is based on 50% of the quoted amount of services.*

Q. Do you use my images from my wedding or event?

A. *There is a section on the last page of the Service Agreement that allows you to make the decision for allowing the use of your images.*

*It is not mandatory and I will never use any images without your consent! It would, however, be an absolute **honor** to be able to add your photos to my portfolio, my brand new blog on my website or to the overall beautification of my business marketing! If you decide to initial that section, you can just email me the pictures you would like me to use.*

Q. Do you airbrush?

A. *Products today are so **amazing** and full of skin loving, skin protecting and skin treating ingredients and technology that I absolutely prefer to use them over airbrushing! The techniques I have learned and tools I use allow me to create all looks such as airbrushed, velvety, glowing, dewy, luminous or radiant finishes!*

Q. How do you clean your brushes and tools and how often?

A. *I come from a strong background within the field of healthcare which has created in me a hyper mindfulness on keeping the highest of standards of cleanliness and sanitary best practice methods.*

Prior to use, my brushes, sponges and Beauty Blenders have been thoroughly shampooed, dried and shaped. Within each event, each tool is sanitized between applications using a high end antibacterial spray cleanser. Once the event is over, I take my tools home and immediately shampoo, dry and shape each one for the next event!

Q. Do you only do makeup for weddings?

A. *I am available for all makeup services including bridal, engagement photos, wedding rehearsals, portraits, special events, makeup for professionals (physicians, attorneys, real estate agents, LinkedIn profiles, etc), student and high school senior photos, proms and beyond!*

Q. Will you stay at my event for touch ups? If not, how do I do my own touch ups?

A. *I am available for wedding day touch ups at an additional hourly rate. Due to my application techniques, touchups, however, are typically not needed and this year's special Wedding Day Service Package includes a complimentary touch up kit for the bride!*
